### **HEALTH OFFICIALS : DRIVE THROUGH CLINIC TOMORROW FOR 500 RED TICKET HOLDERS**

The Corpus Christi-Nueces County Public Health District will hold an H1N1 ((Swine) flu vaccination drive through clinic for the first 500 who pre-registered their children ages 2 to 5 years tomorrow from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the 1702 Horne Road Health District parking lot.

Parents must remember to bring their red numbered ticket (numbers 1-500), their consent form and their questionnaire completed and signed. Anyone without their red numbered ticket will not be admitted to this drive through clinic.

The entrance will be on Greenwood, next to the Senior Center, and will exit through Horne Road. Children must remain in their car seat for their vaccine. The H1N1 flu vaccine will be available in nasal mist spray form.

Again this H1N1 Flu vaccination drive through clinic is only for the first 500 who have already pre-registered. Anyone who has a red ticket that cannot come tomorrow, during the designated clinic time, can call 826-7282 between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, October 27<sup>th</sup> to be given alternative instructions to receive the vaccine.

People who **CANNOT** take the nasal mist H1N1 (Swine Flu) vaccine include the following:

- Allergic to eggs
- Pregnant or nursing
- Over the age of 49 and under the age of 2
- Between 2-17 years of age on aspirin therapy
- Taking any prescription drugs for Cancer, Rheumatoid Arthritis, Asthma, and HIV.
- Previously disqualified to receive live vaccinations
