Reminder: H1N1 Flu Vaccine Clinics This Week

The Corpus-Christi Nueces County Public Health District would like to remind residents they will hold several H1N1 flu vaccine clinics for the general public(ages 6 months and older) this week. Additional clinics have been added for Robstown.

The clinics are scheduled as follows:

- **H1N1 Vaccine Clinic, Sunrise Mall, Saturday, January 16, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., (nasal and injectable vaccine).**
- **H1N1 Flu Vaccine Walk-In Clinic, Health District Auditorium, 1702 Horne Road, Saturday, January 16, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. (both nasal and injectable).**
- **H1N1 Flu Vaccine Walk-In Clinic, Thursday through Saturday, January 14-16, 2009, Richard Borchard Fairgrounds, 1213 Terry Shamsie Boulevard, Robstown, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. (both nasal and injectable). Catholic Charities will also be offering free glucose and blood pressure screenings on the Sat. Jan. 16th clinic at the Richard Borchard Fairgrounds 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.**

There will be no charge for the H1N1 Vaccine. The events are open to the general public. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

The nasal spray H1N1 vaccine is recommended only for persons who are:

- ages 2 to 49 year of age
- healthy
- non-asthmatic
- not pregnant
- not allergic to eggs
- non-diabetic

The H1N1 flu vaccine is subject to availability.

In order to allow for a more efficient flow of the clinic, the Health District is asking those who come to the clinic to download consent forms and sign both sides. Consent forms may be downloaded by going to: www.ccpublichealth.com , then clicking "Swine Flu Information and Consent Forms". Forms will also be available at the clinics. If you have health insurance please bring the information with you.
