H1N1 FLU VACCINE CLINICS FRIDAY & SATURDAY AT SUNRISE MALL

The Corpus Christi-Nueces County Public Health District will hold an H1N1 (Swine) flu vaccination clinic at the former Oshman's Sports Store next to the Burlington's Store located at Sunrise Mall, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. November 6th and 7th or while supplies last. Sunrise Mall is located at 5858 S. Padre Island Drive.

Only the nasal mist spray form of the vaccine will be available. The nasal spray vaccine is only for healthy, non asthmatic persons who are not allergic to eggs. The H1N1 flu vaccination clinic will be limited to these high risk groups:

- Children ages 2 to 9 years
- Household contacts or caretakers of infants 6 months of age or younger (up to age 49 years of age only for the nasal form)
- Medical first responders

*(Children through 9 years of age must get **two doses** of the vaccine, around 30 days apart, to acquire immunity.)

The Health District is asking those who come to the clinic to bring their consent forms, their questionnaire completed and signed. Forms will be available at the Sunrise Mall, the Health District lobby or they can be downloaded on our website at www.ccpublichealth.com .

Health officials indicate that based on the demand of the vaccine on Friday, the Health District may open up Saturday's clinic for children up to the age of 18.

The H1N1 (Swine) flu vaccine is subject to availability. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. For more information contact 2-1-1 or the Health District at 826-7200.
