### **HEALTH OFFICIALS : H1N1 FLU VACCINE CLINIC TO BE HELD TODAY AT SUNRISE MALL**

The Corpus Christi-Nueces County Public Health District will hold an H1N1 (Swine) flu vaccination clinic indoors today October 30<sup>th</sup> from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. or while supplies last. It will be held at the former Oshman's Sports Store located at Sunrise Mall, 5858 S. Padre Island Drive located on the first floor. Individuals should enter through the Padre Island Drive side entrance.

**Only the nasal mist spray form of the vaccine will be available.** Only non asthmatic, healthy individuals, ages 2 to 49 years old, that are not pregnant can receive the nasal spray form. The H1N1 flu vaccination clinic will be limited to these high risk groups:

- Children ages 2 to 5 years (not yet in school)
- Red Ticket Holders (pre-screened high risk)

These 2 high risk groups were added for today:

- Household contacts or caretakers of infants 6 months of age or younger
- Medical first responders

In order to allow for an efficient flow of the clinic, the Health District is asking those who come to these two clinics to bring their consent forms, their questionnaire completed and signed. Forms will be available at the information center at Sunrise Mall, the Health District lobby or they can be downloaded on our website at [www.ccpublichealth.com](http://www.ccpublichealth.com) . Parents with red numbered tickets (numbers 1-500) bringing their child for the vaccine should remember to bring the red ticket with them. **The H1N1 (Swine) flu vaccine is subject to availability.** Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
