Citizens Collection Center at the J.C. Elliott Transfer Station

7001 Ayers (7/10 of a mile south of Saratoga, on the right)

GARBAGE: Twice a week curbside collection.

Includes food waste, packaging, non-recyclable products found in your home.

The Citizens Collection Center at the J.C. Elliott Transfer Station is open to residential Solid Waste customers for free public disposal of garbage. Residential construction materials and tires may be disposed of free only on quarterly scheduled disposal days.

YARD WASTE: Twice a week curbside collection.

Includes grass clippings, weeds, leaves, mulch, small shrubs, limbs or other similar items.

Place yard waste inside the City issued cart along with garbage. The Citizens Collection Center at the J.C. Elliott Transfer Station is open to residential Solid Waste customers for free public disposal of yard waste.

HEAVY BRUSH: Curbside collection according to published schedule.

Includes tree and shrub limbs and trimmings, which are greater than three inches in diameter, tree trunks, root balls, untreated lumber, and other similar items.

Curbside pick-up by special appointment for a fee. The Citizens Collection Center at the J.C. Elliott Transfer Station is open to residential Solid Waste customers for free public disposal of heavy brush.

RECYCLING: Every other week curbside collection.

Includes solid waste materials that can be reused in new products. These include certain paper, metals and plastics.

Place recyclables inside your City issued bin or marked container on the curb. You may also bring your recyclables to any of our drop-off locations:

(open Monday through Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.)

(open Friday through Monday from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.)

(open Friday through Monday from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.)
 - The Fellowship of Oso Creek Church at 7402 Yorktown Boulevard
(open Friday through Monday from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.)

BULKY ITEMS: Twice a year curbside collection only on designated set out periods up to one truckload.

Includes indoor/outdoor furniture, treated lumber, construction materials (excluding concrete and bricks), mattresses and box springs, carpet, swing sets, plastic swimming pools, large toys, bicycles, fish aquariums, and large household appliances.

The Citizens Collection Center at the J.C. Elliott Transfer Station is open to residential Solid Waste customers for free public disposal of bulky items. Curbside collection during non-designated set out periods is available for a fee by special appointment.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE: Curbside collection not available.

Includes used or leftover contents of home products containing hazardous components that are poisonous, corrosive or flammable. These include certain paints, cleaners, stains and varnishes, car batteries, motor oil, and pesticides.

The Citizens Collection Center at the J.C. Elliott Transfer Station is open to residential Solid Waste customers for free public disposal of household hazardous waste.

TIRES: Twice a year curbside collection only on designated set out periods, limit 4 tires / 20" maximum size.

For a fee, the Citizens Collection Center at the J.C. Elliott Transfer Station is open to residential Solid Waste customers for public disposal of tires. Residential tires may be disposed of free only on quarterly scheduled disposal days, limit 4 tires / 20" maximum size.
