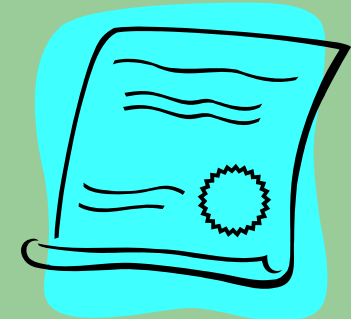

Contractor Licensing

The City of Corpus Christi requires licensed plumbing/mechanical, electrical, and backflow contractors to be licensed by the City. The City regulates this activity to protect the public from unscrupulous or un-licensed people who will put the life, health, and safety of the general public in danger with construction that is not to standards.

Before you begin any construction project, there are some things to consider:

- Is the contractor I have hired licensed to do the work?
- What information does the City provide that will help me determine if the contractor is licensed?

While it may seem confusing, we're here to help make your project a success.

What is Required?

An application for license and fee is required. The contractor credentials will be verified against the many state agencies who issue and regulate their issuance.

If the contractor registration is expired with the state, the City will not accept the application.

In addition, liability insurance is required. This information will be verified by the staff to ensure the coverage is current.

What to Expect

A project manager will take in your application for license and process any remaining paperwork. They will provide you with a printout of the license that shows you are registered to work in the City of Corpus Christi.

How Much Does it Cost?

Depending on the license type, a fee of \$135.00 will be assessed.

Renewals are done yearly, with the renewal fee costing \$135.00.
