Electrical Re-outs

“Electrical Re-out” a complicated term which means re-establishing electrical service in an existing structure or establishing new service in a new home with no prior service. This involves applying for an electrical permit and scheduling an electrical inspection.

Basically, the electrical providers in this area have requested that the City of Corpus Christi inspect all structures seeking electrical service to make sure they are safe to be connected.

This means that although you may believe you are done. Once you place the order for service with the electrical provider, often your order will be delayed until you apply for and schedule an electrical inspection.

Before you get started, there are some important items to consider such as:

- What Approvals or Permits are Required?
- Is the structure safe for electrical work?
- Has any work been done prior to your move in?

What is Required?

In general, an application for an electrical permit and electrical inspection will be required. We will need a valid address and the ESID number that is assigned to the property by the electrical provider.

What to Expect

Once you apply for service from your electrical provider, they will issue a work order number. You will then submit the application for electrical permit and inspection with the City of Corpus Christi. A project manager will help you through the details. The inspection will be scheduled within 24 hours and the results will generally be available the same day as the inspection. Within 48 hours, we will issue a release to AEP or other electrical provider if all safety issues are resolved. If there are issues outstanding, your project manager will notify you of items that need to be repaired. Any additional work will require the issuance of another permit.

We can only issue an electrical permit to a valid electrical contractor or to a homeowner who provides proof that they are homesteading the property.

How Much Does It Cost?

Permits costs start at \$76.88. Prices will vary depending on the project type, scope, complexity, etc. A project manager can provide you with an estimated fees list to help you plan your project
