

COASTAL BEND CULTURAL EDUCATION FACILITIES FINANCE CORPORATION

- DUTIES:** To provide and finance cultural education facilities for the exhibition and promotion of and education about the performing, dramatic, visual and literary arts, natural history and science for the public purpose of promoting the health, education and welfare of the citizens of the State of Texas and to replace Coastal Bend Health Facilities Development Corporation when bonds issued by that entity are either retired or refunded by new bond issue.
- COMPOSITION:** Nine (9) members elected for terms approximately coterminous with the terms of City Council members. Any Director may succeed himself. Any Director who is a public official of the City shall, upon termination of his or her status as a public official, be deemed to have resigned as a Director, which resignation shall be effective at the next regular meeting of the corporation. The officers of the corporation shall be chosen by the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall choose from its members a President and Vice President.
- CREATION & AUTHORITY:** Resolution No. 028272 in accordance with the Cultural Education Facilities Finance Corporation Act, Art. 1528m, V.A. T. C. S; Resolution No. 029241, 10/11/11.
- MEETS:** Regular meetings on call; Special meetings called by the President or by President or Secretary on the written request of two Directors.
- MEMBERS, TERMS, AND EXPIRATION TERMS:** Coterminous with the terms of City Council.
