

TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- DUTIES:** To be responsible for public advisory jurisdiction and citizen traffic safety investigation, traffic accident, injury and damage prevention in the City; developing and implementing coordinated traffic safety programs which meet local needs; acting in an advisory capacity to the City Council and the City Manager in the coordination of traffic safety activities of the official agencies and departments of the City; promoting public acceptance of official programs proposed or initiated by the City; fostering public knowledge and support of traffic law enforcement and traffic safety problems; cooperating with public and private school systems in promoting traffic safety training aids in the schools; promoting the education of the public in traffic safety and, generally assisting in the overall reduction of traffic deaths, injuries, damage, and accidents on the City's streets.
- COMPOSITION:** Nine (9) members appointed by the City Council for three-year terms to provide advice on transportation and traffic safety matters. One member has traditionally been the incumbent security officer at the Naval Air Station. Elects Chairman and Vice-Chairman annually.
- CREATION & AUTHORITY:** Section 2-120, Code of Ordinances. Ordinance No. 3679, 3-3-54; amended by Ord. Nos. 6577, 10079, 10912, 11841, 17526, 20294 - 5-3-88.
- MEETS:** 4th Monday of every month, 2:30 p.m., City Hall, Council Chambers
