

Hope House opens the doors to women who may just be alone and need assistance.

Salvation Army - ESG Rapid Re-housing

Provides residents help with the deposit and one (1) to two (2) months' rent depending on the total cost. Must have a birth certificate, social security card, and I.D. to qualify. Starting October 2023, funds are available, but they will always take applications. If you were evicted, you will need to provide that notice. Surviving spouses of veterans can qualify for ESG Rapid Re-housing, and funding will be available starting July 2023. Ask for Carrie when calling.


