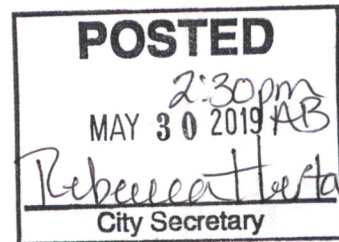




## PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this public meeting is to present information on the Type B funded Slough Road improvement project from Rodd Field Road to Amethyst Drive. The public meeting is an opportunity for stakeholders in and around the project to ask any questions and voice any concerns regarding project improvements.

Improvements to Slough Road include a full-depth reconstruction and widening of the two-lane roadway, new curb and gutter, sidewalks, street lighting, and new underground stormwater system drainage infrastructure. Other improvements include limited upgrades to Ametrine Drive to facilitate traffic access during and after construction.

A brief description and time schedule of the project will be presented. The Design Engineers and City Project Manager will be available to answer questions.
