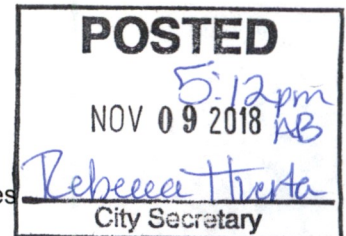


**COMMISSION ON CHILDREN AND YOUTH
