

Set up Online Bill Pay with ClickPay

Unfortunately, effective March 1st the Marina office will no longer be able to accept credit card payments over the phone. All credit card payments must be made in the office with the card present or online with ClickPay.

ClickPay is an online payment system meant to streamline the payment process and allow tenants full access to their account information. With ClickPay you will be able to view your account in real time, set up recurring or one time payments for free with an e-check or with a credit or debit card for a fee. Pay your slip rent, electrical overages, pump outs, and haul out charges from the comfort of your home or vessel.

Tenants with a credit card on file with the Marina office will need to switch over to ClickPay **on their own**. The attached ClickPay flyer has detailed instructions on how to set up your account. You will receive a phone call from the Marina office as a reminder that February will be the last month we'll run automatic credit card payments. The Marina office will automatically transfer all accounts that have a **bank draft** on file to the ClickPay system.

Stay Aboard Permits

When staying over night on your vessel please check in with the office to obtain a stay aboard permit. These permits are a security measure that allow marina patrol to know when someone should or should not be on board your vessel.

Per City Ordinance 12-46 d non live aboards are permitted to stay aboard their vessel only 15 nights in a calendar month.

Permits can be issued in the marina office Monday - Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. or after regular office hours by calling 826-3980.



Pet Ordinance

7- b. Ordinance No. 6-101, the leash law applies to all Marina docks and upland areas.

Pets are permitted at the Marina only if they are not a nuisance.

Examples of nuisance behavior include, but not limited to: noise, threatening demeanor, running at large and creating animal waste on Marina property (all waste material must be immediately cleaned up and disposed of). Owner is responsible for actions of Owner's pets.

Pets may not be tied on docks, walkways or land including gates and/or boaters facilities.

Pets, except for service animals, are not permitted into city facilities



Oil Recycling

Oil recycling receptacles are available on the Coopers Alley L-head. Pads and filters must be separate from any fluid. Call the Marina Office to have a staff member meet you at the disposal center.

****We do not accept gasoline.****



Pump Out Information

For the slips equipped with pump outs, please allow a minimum of **2 hours** notice when calling to request this service.

The Marina office has prepaid pump out cards available for purchase or you can pay the day of; this must be done prior to scheduling.

Staff can not accept payment in the field!!

Pump outs in slip, are scheduled between 8am-3pm.

For your convenience there is a free pump out location at the Coopers Alley L-head adjacent to the fuel station available 24 hours.
