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## **Drs. Ed Proffitt & Donna Devlin** *Texas A&M University – Corpus Christi*

Drs. Ed Proffitt and Donna Devlin and their students address questions critical to the maintenance of ecosystem processes (productivity, biomass, soil subsidence and erosion), community structure and species diversity in the coastal saltmarsh, mangrove, mudflat, and oyster reef habitats in the Gulf of Mexico. This presentation includes discussions of the effects of 1) climate change on Texas coastal wetlands, 2) the expansion of mangroves in Corpus Christi Bay and 3) the February 2021 hard freeze on mangroves along the Texas coast.
