Learn about environmentally-friendly landscaping practices, the free soil-testing program and how improper fertilizer application on residential lawns can negatively impact local waterbodies. How can we keep a lawn and garden green and healthy without hurting our local water quality? Kevin will explain grass choice, soil types, lawn care, and pesticide and fertilizer best management practices. Kevin and Sandra will explain the Coastal Bend Fertilizer and Pesticide Monitoring Program which is currently offering free soil testing for properties in Corpus Christi.

Kevin holds a BS in Ornamental Horticulture from Texas Tech and a Master of Education from Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi. Sandra holds a Master of Science in Environmental Science and manages activities to support the City's Stormwater Quality Management Program which exists to minimize pollution from entering creeks, bays, and estuaries through stormwater runoff.
