Each year, by early Spring, purple martins (*Progne subis*) arrive in Corpus Christi from South America. Although migrating birds living in Corpus for the summer is not unusual, where these birds live is unusual. They are the only birds that rely on man-made bird houses for survival.

As a member of the Purple Martin Conservation Association, Tom maintains the purple martin colonies and houses at the Oso Bay Wetlands Preserve. Join us to learn about being a purple martin landlord and how to start a colony at your residence. We will meet outdoors beneath our purple martin colonies.
