At the East Foundation, we're committed to promoting the advancement of land stewardship. Through ranching, science, and education, we're working to take the reputation of ranching beyond steaks and burgers and prove that the conservation of wildlife and our natural resources can walk hand-in-hand with ranching. By opening our gates and managing our rangeland as a working laboratory, we ensure future generations understand and value these efforts. With over 215,000 acres of native rangeland, the East Foundation has one of the largest ranch holdings in Texas and is ranked by The Land Report as the 46th largest landowner in the nation. The Foundation's lands are in six separate ranches in parts of Jim Hogg, Starr, Willacy and Kenedy counties.

Landon holds a B.S. in Wildlife Resources and a B.S. in Geographic Information Systems from the University of Idaho. He will defend his Master of Science in Wildlife from Louisiana State University in October. On this evening, Landon will provide an overview of the East Foundation and the current research projects being conducted ranging from prescribed fire to the white-tailed deer ecology here in South Texas.
