

Corpus Christi Parks & Recreation's Removal of Park Amenities Project

The City of Corpus Christi Parks & Recreation Department will begin the process of removing wooden playground structures and park amenities from eleven parks in January 2016. The removal of park amenities includes wooden playground systems, shelters, grills, and tables. The removal of these amenities in niche parks was identified as a task in the 2012 Comprehensive Parks & Recreation Master Plan. The structures and amenities will be completely removed and not replaced.

The following are the eleven parks that have park amenities scheduled for removal:
