








Project Vicinity







Project Background



- The Water Garden, built in the 1987, is located between the Art Museum and Museum of Science and History.
- The Water Garden is an architectural water feature with an underground vault housing electrical, mechanical and water treatment equipment.
- The Water Garden suffered the latest catastrophic flooding following Hurricane Harvey in 2017 and has been unserviceable since that time.



Project Scope



Remedy current issues by:

- Replacing Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing (MEP) systems
- Upgrading water fountain equipment
- Other Miscellaneous site improvements
