1. SENIOR CENTERS Renovations & Improvements \$ 1,724,000

Broadmoor – Mechanical/electrical improvements of existing equipment and ADA building improvements.

Ethel Eyerly – Mechanical/electrical improvements of existing equipment.

Garden – Parking lot renovation, mechanical/electrical improvements of existing equipment, roof repairs, minor interior/exterior improvements, and ADA building improvements.

Greenwood – Parking lot renovation & mechanical/electrical improvements of existing equipment.

Lindale – Parking lot renovation and mechanical/electrical improvements of existing equipment.

Northwest – ADA building improvements.

Oveal Williams – Roof repairs & minor interior/exterior renovations to existing facility.

2. RECREATION CENTERS Renovations & Improvements \$ 458,000

Joe Garza – Mechanical/electrical improvements of existing equipment and ADA building improvements.

Lindale – Mechanical/electrical improvements of existing equipment and ADA building improvements.

6. GREENWOOD SPORTS COMPLEX

Improvements \$ 610,000

Sports field lighting improvement for 5 baseball fields.

7. COLE PARK & DIMITT PIERS

Renovations & Improvements \$ 1,288,000

Provides partial funding for the restoration of the Cole Park and Philip Dimitt Fishing Piers. Additional funding will be necessary to complete the full restoration of both structures. Work includes structural repair to piles, decking, fencing and walkways.
