



RESIDENTIAL STREET REBUILD PROGRAM



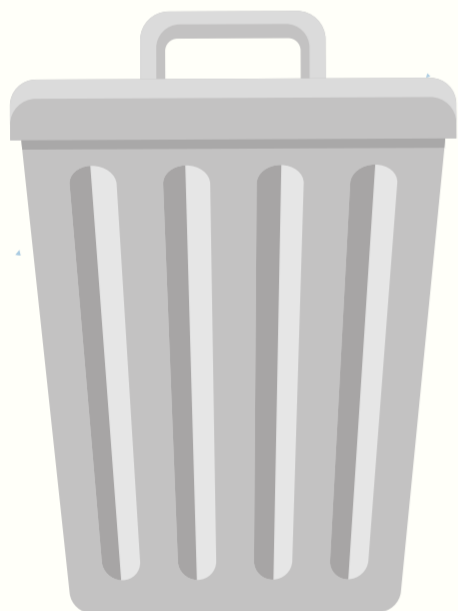
CONSTRUCTION

- Work is expected to begin on your street soon.
- Construction phasing will be about 1 block at a time.
- Work may be underway on various blocks during a transition.
- Construction on your block is expected to take 2 to 3 months.
- City utilities may be evaluated for repair/replacement.
- Curb and gutter repairs will be evaluated for repair/replacement.
- Sidewalk repairs will be limited and will be addressed as needed for ADA compliance.
- Trees may be removed if they undermine the newly built street and/or sidewalk.
- Dust and noise will be minimized as much as possible.
- Residents should be cautious near construction areas.



ACCESS

- When detour signs go up and your street is blocked off, parking restrictions will begin.
- No parking will be allowed between 8 AM and 6 PM, Monday through Friday.
- Vehicles parked on the street during work hours will be towed.
- You will be notified and parking arrangements will be made if your driveway will be blocked.
- Your street will be closed to through traffic, but you will always have access to your home.
- Pedestrian access will be provided on at least one side of the street during construction.



SERVICES

- Construction contractors will work with residents to make sure trash, recycling, and brush pick up will remain on its normal schedule.
