
Construction Updates

Temporary Closure of Cain Drive

The City of Corpus Christi advises motorists about a closure of Cain Drive between Everhart Road and Nelson Lane. This closure is expected to begin on Wednesday, January 15 and will be closed until further notice.

Safety is a top priority, so drivers are reminded to be aware of the work zone, follow all traffic control devices, and use alternate routes to avoid delays.


All work is weather permitting.



Closures included:

- Northbound and Southbound traffic on Everhart Road will continue as one lane for both directions.
- Northbound traffic on Everhart Road, left turns will continue to be allowed at the Holly Road intersection. However, left turns from Southbound Everhart Road traffic will still be restricted.
- The right turn lane on Holly Road will continue to be closed but right turns onto northbound Everhart Road will still be allowed from the right travel lane.
- Sidewalks will continue to be closed along Phase 1 until the completion of the project.




Featured Business
