Construction Updates

Wastewater & Sewer Line Install Moving Along

The contractor spent the week working on the wastewater line between Bonner Drive and Cain Drive as well as the installation of the sewer line at Cain Drive and Everhart Road. Utility work along Phase 1 continues and is on schedule.

Additionally, potholes were also filled along the construction path in order to create a safe lane of travel for drivers.

All work is weather permitting.

Closures included:

- Northbound and Southbound traffic on Everhart Road will continue as one lane for both directions.
- Northbound traffic on Everhart Road, left turns will continue to be allowed at the Holly Road intersection. However, left turns from Southbound Everhart Road traffic will still be restricted.
- The right turn lane on Holly Road will continue to be closed but right turns onto northbound Everhart Road will still be allowed from the right travel lane.
- Sidewalks will continue to be closed along Phase 1 until the completion of the project.


Featured Business
