

Construction Updates

Additional Closures This Week

Work at the intersection of Holly Road and Everhart Road to Cain Drive will continue into next week. Additionally, AEP crews will be relocating power poles from Cain Drive to Bonner Drive. All work is weather permitting. After the current work is complete, the opposite side of Everhart Road, between Holly Road and Bonner Drive, will be closed for additional underground utility work. This switch is anticipated to occur in the next couple of weeks.



Lane closures included:

- **Everhart Road (Southbound)** - Southbound traffic is reduced to one lane beginning at Bonner Drive to the Holly Road intersection. Left turns are prohibited at the Holly Road intersection for southbound traffic.
- **Everhart Road (Northbound)** - Northbound traffic is reduced to one lane beginning at Schanen Boulevard, extending through the Holly intersection and to Cain Drive. Traffic shifts to the west lanes (southbound) through the intersection. Traffic heading northbound on Everhart Road is allowed to make left turns at the Holly Road intersection.
- **Holly Road (Westbound)** - The dedicated right turn lane on westbound Holly Road is closed. Right turns onto northbound Everhart Road are allowed from the right lane.
- **Daily Closures Everhart Road (Northbound)** - Northbound right lanes are closed between Cain Drive and Bonner Drive from 9:00am to 6:00pm. Work and lane closures are estimated to last a few weeks.

Taste of the Middle East on Everhart Road


