





Construction Updates

Lane Closures Remain on Southbound Side

Utility (wastewater) work continues along southbound Everhart Road between Holly Road and Cobblestone Lane. Northbound lanes are still opened to move traffic in both directions. AEP teams continue relocating power poles along northbound Everhart Road. All work is weather permitting.



Lane Closures include:

- **Everhart Road (Northbound)** – Northbound traffic is reduced to one lane between Schanen Boulevard, extending through the Holly intersection, and up to Cain Drive. Traffic heading northbound on Everhart Road can make left turns at the Holly Road intersection.
- **Everhart Road (Southbound)** – Southbound traffic is reduced to one lane and is temporarily shifted between Coventry Lane and the Holly Road intersection. Left turns will still be prohibited at the Holly Road intersection for southbound traffic.
- **Holly Road (Westbound)** - The dedicated right turn lane on westbound Holly Road is closed. Right turns onto northbound Everhart Road are allowed from the right lane.
- **Daily Closures Everhart Road (Northbound)** – Northbound right lanes are closed between Cain Drive and Bonner Drive from 9:00am to 6:00pm. Work and lane closures are estimated to last a few weeks.


