

### Construction Updates

#### Traffic Shift & Intersection Closure

On Thursday, October 31, 2019, City contractors implemented a traffic switch for northbound and southbound lanes on Everhart Road between Bonner Drive and Holly Road.

Wastewater Utility work is underway on the east side of Everhart Road. This work will require an intersection closure at Everhart Road and Bonner Drive (east side).



AEP is continuing to relocate electrical poles along the east side of Everhart Road. This work will require daily closures between Bonner Drive and Curtis Clark. All work is weather permitting.

Lane closures included:

- **Everhart Road (Southbound/Northbound)** - Northbound and Southbound lanes will shift from the east side (northbound lanes) to the west side (southbound lanes) between Bonner Drive and Holly Road. Northbound and Southbound traffic will continue as one lane for both directions.
- **Holly Road (Eastbound)** - The right turn lane on Holly Road will continue to be closed but right turns onto northbound Everhart Road will still be allowed from the right travel lane.
- **Daily Closures Everhart Road (Northbound)** – Northbound right lanes are closed between Bonner Drive and Curtis Clark Drive from 9:00am to 6:00pm. Work and lane closures are estimated to last a few weeks.


#### Business Owner Wants Customers to Stick to Normal Route
