Construction Updates

Intersection Closure Continues

City contractors have completed the traffic switch for northbound and southbound lanes on Everhart Road between Bonner Drive and Holly Road.

Utility construction continues on the east side of Everhart Road. This work requires an intersection closure at Everhart Road and Bonner Drive (east side).



Closures included:

- Northbound and Southbound traffic on Everhart Road will continue as one lane for both directions.
- Northbound traffic on Everhart Road, left turns will continue to be allowed at the Holly Road intersection. However, left turns from Southbound Everhart Road traffic will still be restricted.
- The right turn lane on Holly Road will continue to be closed but right turns onto northbound Everhart Road will still be allowed from the right travel lane.
- The east side of Bonner Drive and Everhart Road intersection is still closed. Left turns for both northbound and southbound Everhart Road traffic will be restricted during the intersection closure. Through traffic on Eastbound Bonner Drive will be detoured around the intersection closure.

AEP is moving along with relocating electrical poles. Crews continue working on the east side of Everhart Road. Daily closures have extended to Corona Drive from Bonner Drive.


