Construction Updates

Concrete Pour Planned Near Bonner Drive and Square Plaza

This week the contractor continued the 36" waterline and 24" stormwater line installation going north from Curtis Clark Drive to South Padre Island Drive. They also worked to prepare the roadway at the Bonner Drive intersection for the upcoming concrete pour.



Next week, the general contractor will be conducting a large concrete pour from the Bonner Drive intersection to the Square Plaza entrance. The concrete pour will begin at 3am on Tuesday, December 8th. The pour is expected to last several hours and will include a small detour.

Safety is a top priority, so motorists and pedestrians are reminded to be aware of the work zone, follow all traffic control devices, and use alternate routes to avoid delays.

All work is weather permitting.

Current Closures:

- Phase 4 will extend the closure of the southbound lanes of Everhart from Holly Road to Corona Drive for construction.
- Northbound and southbound traffic is shifted to the northbound lanes (East side of Everhart), from Holly Road to Corona Drive. Traffic is reduced to one-lane in each direction.
- The transition for southbound Everhart traffic occurs at the Corona Drive Intersection.
- Northbound traffic will not be allowed to turn left at Cobblestone Lane, Coventry Lane, Bonner Drive, Curtis Clark Drive, and Corona Drive.
- Southbound traffic will not be allowed to turn left on Curtis Clark Drive, Bonner Drive, Cain Drive, and Holly Road.
- Sidewalks will be closed along the westside of Everhart from Holly Road to Corona Drive.
- The westside of the Bonner Drive is closed at Everhart Road.
- The intersections of Cobblestone Lane, Coventry Lane, and Curtis Clark Drive will temporarily close when work is occurring at these intersections.




Corpus Christi Southside Farmers' Market on Everhart Road
