### Construction Updates

#### Temporary Road Closures Scheduled for Next Week!

Temporary road closures will take place on the Northbound side of Everhart Road from Curtis Clark Drive to South Padre Island Drive as AEP is continuing to relocate new power poles in the area.

Phase 1 of the Everhart Road Project progresses as the contractor continues to install a 30" sewer line from Bonner Drive to Holly Road.



All work is weather permitting.

Closures included:

- Northbound and Southbound traffic on Everhart Road will continue as one lane for both directions.
- Northbound traffic on Everhart Road, left turns will continue to be allowed at the Holly Road intersection. However, left turns from Southbound Everhart Road traffic will still be restricted.
- The right turn lane on Holly Road will continue to be closed but right turns onto northbound Everhart Road will still be allowed from the right travel lane.
- The east side of Bonner Drive and Everhart Road intersection is still closed. Left turns for both northbound and southbound Everhart Road traffic will be restricted during the intersection closure. Through traffic on Eastbound Bonner Drive will be detoured around the intersection closure.


### Featured Business
