### Construction Updates

#### Phase 1 & Phase 2 Moving Along Quickly

As part of Phase 1, the contractor worked this week to complete concrete work on driveways, sidewalks, and ADA Ramps, along the east side of Bonner Drive and Everhart Road. The contractor hopes to be able to open the intersection by the end of the day Friday, May 22, 2020. Next week, additional concrete work will continue in the same area.



As part of Phase 2, the contractor continued working on the underground utilities from Curtis Clark Drive. to Corona Drive. Next week, crews will begin working on sidewalks & ADA ramps between Bonner Drive and Curtis Clark Drive and continue utilities work from Curtis Clark Drive to Corona Drive.

The intersection of Bonner Drive at Everhart Road (east half) is currently closed. During the upcoming week, the contractor plans to finish construction at this location. Once complete, Bonner Drive will be reopened, and the contractor will then close the Curtis Clark intersection (east half) to thru traffic.

All work is weather permitting.

Closures include:

- Northbound lanes are closed from Holly Road to Corona Drive for construction.
- Northbound and southbound is shifted to the southbound lands (west side), from Holly Road to Corona Drive. Traffic is reduced to one-lane in each direction.
- Northbound traffic on Everhart Road will continue to be allowed to make left turns at the Holly Road intersection.
- Left turns from southbound Everhart Road traffic will still be restricted at Holly Road, Bonner Drive and Curtis Clark Drive.
- Left turns from northbound Everhart Road traffic will be restricted at Bonner Drive, Curtis Clark Drive and Corona Drive.
- The right turn lane on Holly Road is closed but right turns onto northbound Everhart Road is allowed from the right travel lane.
- Sidewalks will continue to be closed along Phase 1 until the completion of the project. Phase 2 sidewalks will also be closed along the east side of Everhart Road from Bonner Drive to Corona Drive.
- Phase 2 northbound lanes are closed from Bonner Drive to Curtis Clark Drive.
- The right turn lane on Holly road is closed, but right turns onto northbound Everhart Road will still be allowed from the right travel lane.



#### Road Construction is a Good Sign for Comic Book Shop Owner
