Construction Updates

Waterline Install Complete on Phase 2 Construction

This week, the Phase 1 contractor worked to complete sidewalk installation at the intersection of Cain Drive and Everhart Road. Crews also installed ADA ramps from Everhart Road to Bonner Drive. Next week, the contractor will continue to pour concrete for the new sidewalks and ADA ramps at the intersection of Holly Road/Everhart Road and Cain Drive/Bonner Drive.



As part of the Phase 2 construction process, the contractor completed work on the 8" waterline and begin installing the 10" sewer line. Next week, the contractor will continue working on sidewalks and ADA ramps at the intersection of Bonner Drive/Everhart Road and the intersection of Curtis Clark Drive/Everhart Road. Utilities work is also scheduled to continue from Curtis Clark Drive to Corona Drive.

Safety is a top priority, so motorists and pedestrians are reminded to be aware of the work zone, follow all traffic control devices, and use alternate routes to avoid delays.

Closures include:

- Northbound lanes are closed from Holly Road to Corona Drive for construction.
- Northbound and southbound traffic is shifted to the southbound lanes (west side), from Holly Road to Corona Drive. Traffic is reduced to one-lane in each direction.
- Northbound traffic on Everhart Road will continue to be allowed to make left turns at the Holly Road intersection.
- Left turns from southbound Everhart Road will still be restricted at Holly Road, Bonner Drive and Curtis Clark Drive.
- Left turns from northbound Everhart Road will be restricted at Bonner Drive, Curtis Clark Drive and Corona Drive.
- The right turn lane on Holly Road is closed but right turns onto northbound Everhart Road is allowed from the right travel lane.
- Sidewalks will continue to be closed along Phase 1 until the completion of the project. Phase 2 sidewalks will also be closed along the east side of Everhart Road from Bonner Drive to Corona Drive.
- Phase 2 northbound lanes are closed from Bonner Drive to Curtis Clark Drive.
- The right turn lane on Holly road is closed, but right turns onto northbound Everhart Road will still be allowed from the right travel lane.
