Temporary Traffic Control in Place

Temporary traffic control barricades were placed this week along the west side of Ayers Street from Nemece Street to McArdle Road. AEP is continuing to prep for the relocation of poles on the west side of Ayers Street and McArdle Road.

Exploratory work will continue into next week as contractors work to locate and then relocate existing underground utilities in preparation for the install of a new reinforced concrete box along the west side of Ayers Street from Nemece Street to Gollihar Road.
