Traffic Control Plan Approved

Beginning March 24, the Ayers Street pedestrian project contractor will begin installing the Traffic Control Plan. The install will include barricades and blue business signs along the west side of Ayers Street. Traffic flow will be one-way southbound from Gollihar Road to McArdle Road and two-way from McArdle Road to South Padre Island Drive.



Additionally, message boards directing traffic were put in place and the sub-contractor is expected to begin performing exploratory work once the traffic control install is complete.

All work is weather permitting.

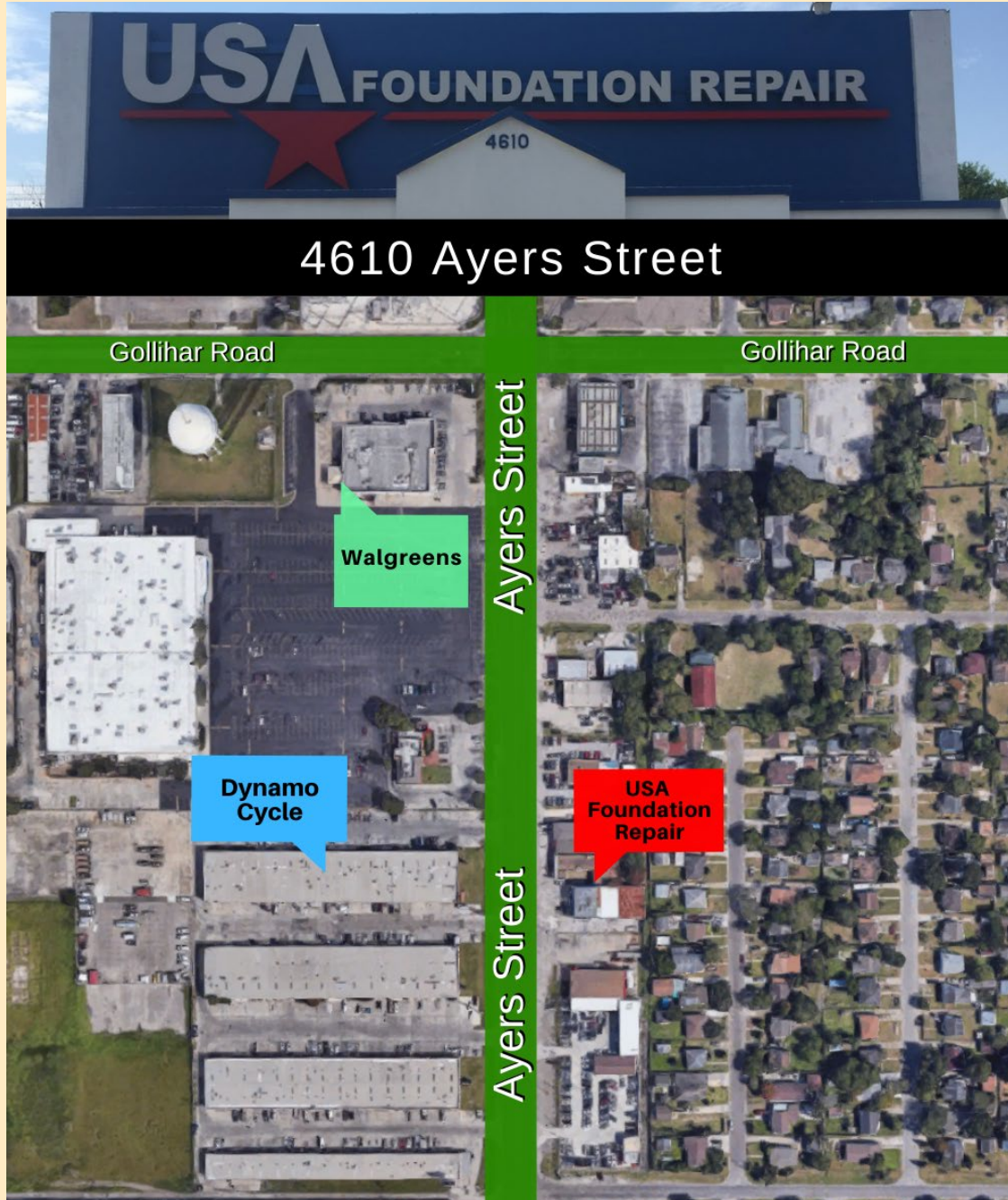
