Construction Updates

Ayers Street Opened for North and Southbound Traffic

This week, the contractor completed adjustments to manholes and valves and began work to install permanent pavement markings and signage. Ayers Street was opened for both northbound and southbound traffic this week.

Next week, installation of permanent signage and pavement striping along Ayers Street is expected to continue. The RTA will also begin work on Bus Stops.

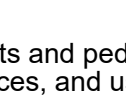
Safety is a top priority, so motorists and pedestrians are reminded to be aware of the work zone, follow all traffic control devices, and use alternate routes to avoid delays.

Traffic:

Motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians can expect short-term daily lane or sidewalk closures as the contractor completes work on minor construction items Ayers Street from South Padre Island Drive to Gollihar Road.

RTA bus stops are closed from Gollihar Road to SPID. Bus stops remain open at the Port Ayers Transfer Station.

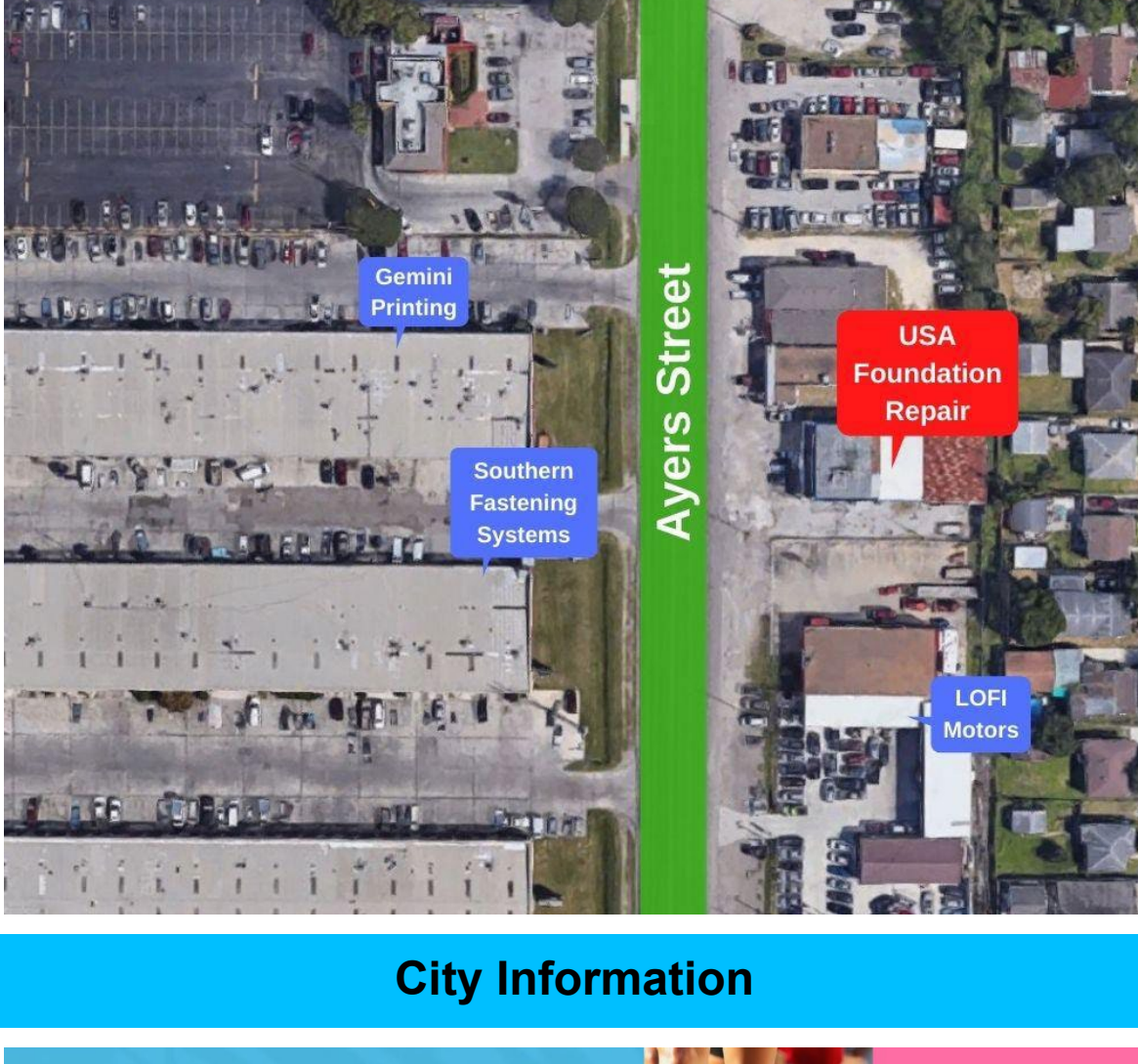
