Construction Updates

Ayers Street Contractor Works Towards Final Project Completion

This week, permanent signage installation and pavement striping installation and cleaning of all curbs, gutters, and inlets.

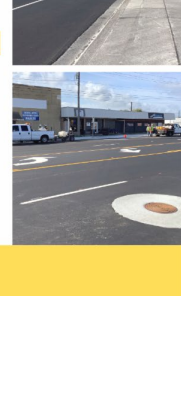
Next week, the contractor will work on minor construction items. The RTA is expected to continue work on Bus Stops.

Safety is our top priority. Motorists and pedestrians are reminded to be aware of the work zone, follow all traffic control devices, and use alternate routes to avoid delays.

Traffic:

Motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians can expect short-term daily lane or sidewalk closures as the contractor completes work on minor construction items on Ayers Street from South Padre Island Drive to Gollihar Road.

RTA bus stops are closed from Gollihar Road to SPID. Bus stops remain open at the Port Ayers Transfer Station.
